## INDIAN-ORIGIN SCIENTIST MAKES LEADLESS PACEMAKER

The world's first leadless pacemaker, developed by an Indian-origin scientist Vivek Reddy, has shown promising results after one year of human trials on 32 pawho received pacemaker.

"This is the first time we have seen one-year follow-up data for this innovative, wireless cardiac pacing technology. Our results comparable to traditional pacemakers," said Reddy, director of arrhythmia services at the Mount Sinai Hospital here.

The findings further support the promising performance and safety of this minimally-invasive, nonsurgical pacing device.

The follow-up study evaluated 32 patients with a slowed heartbeat (bradycardia) who successfully received St. Jude Medical's "Nanos-



tim" leadless pacemaker at two hospitals in Prague and one in Amsterdam. "There was no experience of infections or failure to sense, pace or communicate with the pacemaker," Reddy noted.

The leadless cardiac pacemaker is placed directly inside a patient's heart without surgery during a catheter-guided procedure through the groin via the femoral vein. The device, resembling a tiny, silver tube and smaller than a triple-A battery, is only a few centimetres in length, making it less than 10 percent the size of a traditional pacemaker.

It works by closely monitoring the heart's electrical rhythms and if the heart beat is too slow it proelectrical stimulation therapy to regulate it.

"More long-term follow-up of these 'leadless' study patients will further our understanding of the potential advantages, benefits, and complication risks of leadless pacemaker technology, along with additional ongoing, larger trials," Reddy said.

# India to UN: Set own house in order, implement UNSC reforms

India has said the United Nations should "set its house in order" and implement the much-delayed reform of the Security Council before it seeks to embark upon an ambitious post-2015 development agenda.

It also said the relevance of the world body is at stake if the UN is not reformed to be more effective and representative. India's Permanent Representative to the UN Asoke Mukerji yesterday said an "over-riding view" of a majority of participants in the previous five rounds of talks is that the requirement to reform the Council to make it more effective and representative cannot be de-

He was addressing an informal plenary meeting of the Intergovernmental Negotiations (IGN) on 'Question of equitable representation on and increase in the membership of the Security Council and other matters

related to the Council'. "During these past months, even as we have engaged in making statements at each other, the Security Council has been paralyzed by its inherent flaws. The result of this paralysis is visible. The failure of the Security Council to respond to eruptions of crises, and create sustainable frameworks of political stability, whether on the continent of Africa, or in Asia and in Europe, has been starkly documented for the wider public.

"This failure has already extracted a huge human and material cost, which the UN can ill afford at a time our organization is poised to articulate the blueprint for the post-2015 Development Agenda for the World. At stake is the relevance of the United Nations to embark upon such an ambitious exercise when it has not been able to set its house in order,"

Mukerji said. The sixth meeting of the IGN saw participation of 64 speakers, of which more than 40 spoke in favour of India's position for early UNSC reforms. There was broad convergence on expanding the Council in both perma-

Lawyer Javed Iqbal Jafri had filed the petition against 64 politicians, alleging they had transferred at least \$3,00,000 million to forcountries through money laundering, causing a huge loss to the national exchequer. The Lahore high court, on Friday, issued notices to the federal government and the 64 politicians, including Punjab's chief minister Shahbaz Sharif and Pakistan Tehreek-i-Insaf chief Imran Khan for May 29.

## Search for Nigerian schoolgirls 'challenging', says US

Washington

An American team which arrived in Nigeria to assist the Abuja government in finding more than 200 schoolgirls abducted by Boko Haram militant group faces a "challenging" task, US officials have said

"It's challenging. Time is of the essence. It's been, I think, 25 days now since these girls were taken. We're going to do everything possible. Given the circumstances, it's tough, and I don't want to make any predictions about the outcome," State Department Spokesperson Jen Psaki said.

A team of eight US officials arrived in Abuja, the Nigerian Capital. This includes seven from the US Africa Command and one from the State Depart-Another interagency team of seven officials - three each from the FBI and the State Department and one from the US-AID - are scheduled to land on Saturday.

"These individuals will be complementing our team on the ground. ments," Kirby said.

They'll be working with authorities and local populations. They'll be providing technical and investigatory assistance, helping with hostage negotiations, advising on military planning and operations, and assisting with intelligence and information," Psaki said, adding priority is to get the girls back to their families. ## Tensions soar in east Ukraine ahead of reterendu

Tensions were running at fever pitch in eastern Ukraine today on the eve of an independence referendum, as rebels briefly held several Red Cross staff on suspicion of espionage.

While preparations were in full swing for the disputed vote in the two eastern regions of Donetsk and Lugansk, the port city of Mariupol to the south observed a day of mourning for at least 21 killed in violent clashes yesterday.

The West believes the referendum could lead to the two regions asking to join Russia and has stressed that holding the vote will deepen what is already the worst crisis in relations with Moscow since the end of the Cold War.

The International Committee of the Red Cross in Geneva said nine of its staff - four from Donetsk, four from Kiev and one from Switzerland -- were held "for a few hours" before being released apparently unharmed. "What we know is

that no one was injured," David Pierre Marquet, ICRC spokesman for Europe and Central Asia, told AFP.

"They were there to evaluate the needs of the population in Donetsk. That is probably why they were freed so quickly, their mandate was very clear," he added. Earlier today, Kiril Rudenko, deputy spokesman for the self-pro-

claimed "People's Republic

of Donetsk", said the Red

Cross workers had been detained because the rebels thought they were spies.

'They were arrested yesterday. We suspect they were engaged in espionage and we are currently checking these accusations," said Rudenko. The brief detention underscored jitters in the two regions of east Ukraine ahead of the disputed referendum likely to result in a new spike of

## ASEAN must tackle China sea claims: Aquino

Philippine President Benigno Aquino III said on Saturday that he would raise his country's territorial dispute with China at a meeting of Southeast Asian leaders and call for support to resolve the conflict through international arbitration.

In a statement issued before departing for the 24th Association of Southeast Asian Nations summit in

Myanmar, Aquino said dialogue between two countries is not enough to settle issues that also affect others in the region. Philippines presented evi-

dence in March to an international tribunal against China's sweeping territorial claims in the South China ignoring Beijing's warning that the case would damage bilateral ties.

Manila brought its territorial dispute with China to



international arbitration in January 2013 after Chinese government ships took control of a shoal claimed by the Philippines. "Let us uphold and follow the rule of law in resolving territorial

disputes in order to give due recognition and respect to the rights of all nations," Aquino said in his statement. "We cannot rely just on dialogues between only two nations to settle issues that affect others in the region.

In addition to the Philippines and Myanmar, also includes Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam. In the latest spat between the Philippines and China, Filipino maritime police arrested 11 Chinese fishermen who allegedly illegally collected more than 300 endangered marine turtles in a disputed shoal close to the western province of Palawan.Manila has ignored Beijing's demands to release the fishermen and their boat apprehended early last week by the police at the Half Moon Shoal.

## Director Prakash Jha hopes to be 3rd time lucky in W Champaran

Prakash Jha, famous for his socio-political films like "Gangaajal", "Rajneeti" and "Satyagraha", is hoping to be third time lucky by unseating sitting MP Sanjay Jaiswal of BJP in the Paschim Champaran Lok Sabha seat in Bihar.

Contesting on a JD(U) ticket, the 61-year-old movie director is among the 12 contestants in the constituency. According to political observers, apart from Jaiswal, RJD's Raghunath Jha, who was MP from here in 2004, is also seen as a strong contender for this seat where over 12.2 lakh electors would go to vote on May 12. Jha, a native of Bettiah, administrative headquarters of West Champaran district, is hoping to cash in on the goodwill created by the development works undertaken by Chief Minister Nitish Kumar in the area in the past eight years. Jha had unsuccessfully contested as an Independent in 2004 and on an LJP ticket in 2009 from Paschim Champaran. Political observers say that the JD(U) contestant will have a tough time against BJP's Jaiswal as the socalled 'Modi wave' has found resonance.

## 'Dilli Chalo' goal for another Bose in maiden poll foray

After Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, 'Dilli Chalo' seems to be the rallying cry for yet another member of his family, Sugata Bose, who is aiming to enter Parliament from Jadavpur seat which has in the past seen pitched poll battles between West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee and her Left rivals, reports PTI.

57-year-old Bose, a Harvard University professor, is the Trinamool Congress candidate for Jadavpur Lok Sabha seat. He is the grand nephew of Netaji, the founder of the Indian National Army (INA).

In his maiden poll contest, Sugata Bose is pitted against painter Samir Aich of Congress and seasoned CPI(M) leader Sujan Chakraborty.

Jadavpur votes in the last phase of the 16th general elections on May 12. The constituency has 15.7 lakh voters. Sugata Bose's mother, three-time MP Krishna Bose, had fought on a TMC ticket from this seat in 2004, but had lost to CPI(M)'s Chakraborty. This time, as he campaigns for votes here, Sugata Bose is counting on his mother's links with the constituency to fight the 'outsider' tag.

CPI(M)'s Chakraborty claims that the Harvard professor does not even stay long enough in India to understand the ground realities. But besides his political opponents, another concern for Bose is campaigning by a large number of his own family members for the Left candidate. These family members are unhappy with Sugata Bose as he refused to support the demand for declassification of the files which can reveal the mystery surrounding the disappearance of Netaji in 1945.

"He (Sugata Bose) has told us that declassification is a non-issue. He has betrayed us and (Netaji) Bose's legacy and so we are asking people not to vote for him," says Chandra Bose, another grand-nephew of the freedom fighter. Some members of Netaji's family have also complained against Sugata Bose to Election Commission for "misusing" the name of the freedom fighter for political gains. In a letter to the poll watchdog, they said that Sugata Bose has been conducting his campaign accompanied by a child wearing spectacles and uniform like Subhas Chandra Bose. Netaji had famously given his cry of 'Dilli Chalo (On to Delhi)' to motivate the soldiers of INA as they fought against the Britishers.CPI(M)'s Chakraborty is seen as a strong candidate for the seat and would be confident of his chances this time against Sugata Bose, whose mother he had defeated here in 2004 by a margin of more than 89,000 votes. But Chakraborty lost the seat in 2009 when National Award- winning musician Kabir Suman won by a mar gin of 56,000 votes on a TMC ticket from here.

## I will stop Modi, says Lalu

PATNA: RJD chief Lalu Prasad on Saturday said he will stop BJP's prime ministerial candidate Narendra Modi, in the same manner he had stopped his "guru" LK Advani's 'rath yatra' in 1990. "I will stop the Modi juggernaut," Lalu Prasad said at election rallies in three places - East and West Champaran and Valmikinagar parliamentary constituencies on the last day of campaigning for the Lok Sabha polls. The former Bihar chief minister said he was confident of stopping Modi, the "chela" (disciple) of Advani. "Chela ko bhi rokenge jaise guru ko roka tha (I will stop the disciple like I had stopped his guru). It is a fact of history," he said, referring to Advani's rath yatra in 1990 in Bihar. "With overwhelming people support, I will stop Modi," the Rashtriya Janata Dal chief said to loud applause.

### Bismillah's kin at Rahul's roadshow

Bismillah Khan on Saturday played shehnai during Rahul Gandhi's massive road show here but they clarified that thereperformance was not an endorsement of Congress and should not be seen through prism of politics. "We would have performed for Narendra Modi and even Arvind Kejriwal. We do not have any political affiliations. No one should mix politics with music," said Afaque Haider, grandson of the late shehnai maestro.

Muzaffarnagar: Ban on victory processions

MUZAFFARNAGAR (UP): Ahead of counting of votes for Lok Sabha polls on Friday, victory processions have been banned by authorities in the district as a precautionary measure. "Such processions after poll results have been banned as a precautionary measure to maintain law and order," District Magistrate Koshal Raj Sharma said. Security has been tight and prohibitory orders clamped in the district which was hit by communal riots in September last year that left more that 60 people dead and witnessed a high voltage campaign. Strict action would be taken against those found violating prohibitory orders, the DM said. Counting of votes will take place on May 16.

**Repolling underway in Nagaland**KOHIMA: Repolling in two polling stations and polling in one booth was being held on Saturday in Longleng and Zunheboto districts of Nagaland on Saturday. Polling was being conducted at Ladaigarh Polling Station No 1(one) in Longleng district as people could not cast their votes due to "forcible occupation" of the polling station at Ladaigarh Government LP School allegedly by Assam police on April 9. Polling was arranged at Piching Nullah area in the village for the day, Returning Officer Temjen Toy said. Senior civil and police officials are camping in the area to oversee the conduct of the poll.
