

सनराइजर्स 8 विकेट से जीता



नई दिल्ली। सनराइजर्स हैदराबाद ने दिल्ली डेयरडेविल्स को 8 विकेट से हरा दिया। लगातार जारी बारिश के कारण हैदराबाद को 5 ओवर में 43 न बनाये। इस टारगेट को हैदराबाद ने 4 ओवर में 2 विकेट के नुकसान पर हासिल कर लिया। बारिश से लगातार बाधा के बाद सनराइजर्स हैदराबाद को दिल्ली डेयरडेविल्स के खिलाफ आठवें मैच में 5 ओवर में 43 न बनाते का संतोषित टारगेट मिला। दिल्ली ने पहले बैटिंग करते हुए 20 ओवर में 7 विकेट पर 143 न बनाए। हैदराबाद ने खेल रुकने तक दूसरी पारी में दो ओवर में एक विकेट

पर 17 न बना लिए थे लेकिन लगातार बारिश के कारण दो बार टारगेट बदले गए। पहले हैदराबाद को 15 ओवर में 117 न का टारगेट मिला था। बारिश जारी रहने पर दोबारा 12 ओवर में 97 न का टारगेट हैदराबाद को मिला। फिर इसे 5 ओवर में 43 न कर दिया गया। दिल्ली डेयरडेविल्स ने रविवार को बारिश से प्रभावित आठवें मैच में सनराइजर्स हैदराबाद के खिलाफ 7 विकेट पर 143 न का सम्मानजनक स्कोर खड़ा किया था। सनराइजर्स हैदराबाद के केप्टन सिखर धवन ने टॉस जीतकर दिल्ली को बैटिंग का नौता दिया। मेजबान टीम के लिए दिनेश कार्तिक ने सबसे ज्यादा 39, केप्टन केविन पीटरसन ने 35 और मर्नक अग्रवाल ने 25 न का योगदान दिया। पारी के ब्रेक के दौरान दोबारा बारिश आ गई जिससे दूसरी पारी शुरू होने में देरी हुई। हैदराबाद के लिए डेल स्टैन, अमित मिश्रा और मोइजेज हेनरिक्स ने दो-दो विकेट चटकए जबकि

पुनर्वसन कुमार को एक विकेट मिला। पीटरसन (19 बॉल में 35 न, चार चौके और दो छक्के) टीम के लिए अच्छी पारी खेलते हुए दिख रहे थे, लेकिन मिश्रा ने अपने बल्लेबाजी के लिए आमंत्रित किया। पीटरसन का कैच हैदराबाद के केप्टन सिखर धवन ने लाफा। इस तरह दिल्ली ने 54 न पर दूसरा विकेट को दिया। मिश्रा ने अपने दूसरे ओवर में अग्रवाल (18 बॉल में 25 न, चार चौके) को भी पहिलियन की राह दिखायी जो बाउंड्री लाइन पर डेविड वॉर्नर को कैच दे बैले।

रमेश रतन बुक्का (22 बॉल में 21 न) कप्तान पर उतारे। श्रुतला और कार्तिक (30 बॉल में 39 न, एक छक्का, एक चौका) ने मिलकर कुछ अच्छे शॉट लगाए और टीम ने 12.5 ओवर में 100 न पर पूरे किए। इसके बाद बारिश और आंधी आने से करीब एक घंटे तक खेल रुका रहा। बारिश आने के समय टीम ने 13.1 ओवर में तीन विकेट पर 103 न बना लिए थे।

प्लेऑफ के लिए दावा पक्का करने उतरेगी पंजाब

INDIAN-ORIGIN SCIENTIST MAKES LEADLESS PACEMAKER

New York

The world's first leadless pace-maker, developed by an Indian-origin scientist Vivek Reddy, has shown promising results after one year of human trials on 32 patients who received the pacemaker.

"This is the first time we have seen one-year follow-up data for this innovative, wireless cardiac pacing technology. Our results

show the leadless pacemaker is comparable to traditional pace-makers," said Reddy, director of arrhythmia services at the Mount Sinai Hospital here.

The findings further support the promising performance and safety of this minimally-invasive, non-surgical pacing device.

The follow-up study evaluated 32 patients with a slowed heartbeat (bradycardia) who successfully received St. Jude Medical's "Nanos-



tim" leadless pacemaker at two hospitals in Prague and one in Amsterdam. "There was no experience of infections or failure to

sense, pace or communicate with the pacemaker," Reddy noted.

The leadless cardiac pacemaker is placed directly inside a patient's heart without surgery during a catheter-guided procedure through the groin via the femoral vein. The device, resembling a tiny, silver tube and smaller than a triple-A battery, is only a few centimetres in length, making it less than 10 percent the size of a traditional pacemaker.

It works by closely monitoring the heart's electrical rhythms and if the heart beat is too slow it provides electrical stimulation therapy to regulate it.

"More long-term follow-up of these 'leadless' study patients will further our understanding of the potential advantages, benefits, and complication risks of leadless pacemaker technology, along with additional ongoing, larger trials," Reddy said.

India to UN: Set own house in order, implement UNSC reforms

United Nations

India has said the United Nations should "set its house in order" and implement the much-delayed reform of the Security Council before it seeks to embark upon an ambitious post-2015 development agenda.

It also said the relevance of the world body is at stake if the UN is not reformed to be more effective and representative. India's Permanent Representative to the UN Asoke Mukerji yesterday said an "over-riding view" of a majority of participants in the previous five rounds of talks is that the requirement to reform the Council to make it more effective and representative cannot be de-

laid any longer.

He was addressing an informal plenary meeting of the Intergovernmental Negotiations (IGN) on 'Question of equitable representation on and increase in the membership of the Security Council and other matters related to the Council'.

"During these past months, even as we have engaged in making statements at each other, the Security Council has been paralyzed by its inherent flaws. The result of this paralysis is visible. The failure of the Security Council to respond to eruptions of crises, and create sustainable frameworks of political stability, whether on the continent of Africa, or in Asia and in Europe, has been

starkly documented for the wider public.

"This failure has already extracted a huge human and material cost, which the UN can ill afford at a time our organization is poised to articulate the blueprint for the post-2015 Development Agenda for the World. At stake is the relevance of the United Nations to embark upon such an ambitious exercise when it has not been able to set its house in order," Mukerji said.

The sixth meeting of the IGN saw participation of 64 speakers, of which more than 40 spoke in favour of India's position for early UNSC reforms. There was broad convergence on expanding the Council in both perma-

nent and non-permanent categories of membership and for delivering concrete outcomes by 2015, a position supported by countries such as Japan, Brazil, South Africa, Nigeria, Germany, UK, France, Nicaragua, Palau, Benin, Malawi, St. Vincent and Grenadines and nearly 30 more countries. Mukerji said the mandate for "early reforms" of the UN Security Council was given by global leaders at the 60th anniversary Summit of the United Nations in 2005 and UN member states must build on the convergences to carry the negotiations forward and concrete outcomes for adoption by the 70th Anniversary Summit of the UN

Canada orders mother, uncle extradited to India

Vancouver

The mother and uncle of a young Canadian woman who was the victim of an alleged "honour killing" have been ordered extradited to India. Malkit Kaur Sidhu and Surjit Singh Badesha stand accused of killing Jaswinder Sidhu who was stabbed to death in Punjab in June 2000. The prosecution alleges the pair orchestrated the murder because Sidhu married a poor rickshaw driver in India, rather than the wealthy older man they preferred, supposedly dishonouring the family's reputation. Sidhu, 25, secretly married against the wishes of her family and fled Canada for India to reunite with her husband. BC Supreme Court Justice Gregory Fitch announced the extradition order yesterday.

Thai 'Red Shirts' warn to escalate fight to defend govt

Bangkok

Thailand's pro-government "Red Shirts" on Saturday warned of "escalating" their fight if there was a coup or an unelected premier installed as they gathered here to take on rival protesters who have launched a "final battle" following the removal of Prime Minister Yingluck Shinawatra.

Thousands of police officers were on stand-by for the "Red Shirt" rally on the western outskirts of Bangkok as a large turnout is expected later this evening.

"We will not use violence but we will use the power of

the masses to fight for democracy," a Red Shirt leader said. The anti-government People's Democratic Reform Committee (PDRC) launched its "all-out final battle" after Yingluck, Thailand's only woman premier, was ordered to step down as premier by the Constitutional Court over abuse of power.

The protesters, who have been campaigning for six months for the ouster of the government, are seeking to install an unelected premier. They want the entire Cabinet to be removed and an unelected "people's council" to be set up. Jatuporn

Prompan, who heads the Red Shirts, said: "As long as the country's democracy is not safe, we will be here." He warned that if there was a coup or an unelected prime minister installed, the Red Shirts will "escalate our fight immediately".

Hours after Yingluck and her nine ministers were removed from office, the Cabinet named deputy premier Niwattumrong Boonsongpaisan as acting prime minister. But protest leader Suthep Thaugsuban told followers the Senate should select a new premier since the lower house had been dissolved since December.

Pak court issues notice to Sharif, Zardari over foreign assets

Lahore

A Pakistani court has issued notices to Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif, former President Asif Ali Zardari and 62 other politicians on a petition seeking direction for them to bring back their assets from abroad.

Lawyer Javed Iqbal Jafri had filed the petition against 64 politicians, alleging they had transferred at least \$3,00,000 million to foreign countries through money laundering, causing a huge loss to the national exchequer. The Lahore high court, on Friday, issued notices to the federal government and the 64 politicians, including Pun-

jab's chief minister Shah-baz Sharif and Pakistan Tehreek-i-Insaf chief Imran Khan for May 29.

The petitioner said these politicians had not yet submitted to the court, their affidavits regarding alleged money laundering despite court orders. He said Pakistan would not have required foreign loans if assets of the politicians were brought back to return the international loan of the country. He asked the court to issue directions to the politicians to bring back their assets. Justice Khalid Mahmood Khan adjourned the hearing till May 29 and sought replies from the respondents.

Search for Nigerian schoolgirls 'challenging', says US

Washington

An American team which arrived in Nigeria to assist the Abuja government in finding more than 200 schoolgirls abducted by Boko Haram militant group faces a "challenging" task, US officials have said here.

"It's challenging. Time is of the essence. It's been, I think, 25 days now since these girls were taken. We're going to do everything possible. Given the circumstances, it's tough, and I don't want to make any predictions about the outcome," State Department Spokesperson Jen Psaki said.

A team of eight US officials arrived in Abuja, the Nigerian Capital. This includes seven from the US Africa Command and one from the State Department. Another inter-agency team of seven officials - three each from the FBI and the State Department and one from the US-AID - are scheduled to land on Saturday.

"These individuals will be complementing our team on the ground.

They'll be working with authorities and local populations. They'll be providing technical and investigatory assistance, helping with hostage negotiations, advising on military planning and operations, and assisting with intelligence and information," Psaki said, adding priority is to get the girls back to their families. At the Pentagon, Defense Secretary Chuck Hagel received two briefings on the status of the US efforts to support Nigeria in locating the missing girls.

The first was a face-to-face briefing from Africa Command commander; the second was from Africa experts on his staff, Pentagon Press Secretary Rear Admiral John Kirby said.

"Both briefings covered the details surrounding the additional team members the military is sending to Nigeria as part of the inter-disciplinary coordination cell, as well as a sense of what we know about the kidnapping and Boko Haram's activities in the region. The Secretary will closely monitor developments," Kirby said.

Tensions soar in east Ukraine ahead of referendum

Donetsk

Tensions were running at fever pitch in eastern Ukraine today on the eve of an independence referendum, as rebels briefly held several Red Cross staff on suspicion of espionage.

While preparations were in full swing for the disputed vote in the two eastern regions of Donetsk and Lugansk, the port city of Mariupol to the south observed a day of mourning for at least 21 killed in violent clashes yesterday.

The West believes the referendum could lead to the two regions asking to join Russia and has stressed that holding the vote will deepen what is already the worst crisis in relations with Moscow since the end of the Cold War.

The International Committee of the Red Cross in Geneva said nine of its staff - four from Donetsk, four from Kiev and one from Switzerland - were held "for a few hours" before being released apparently unharmed. "What we know is

that no one was injured," David Pierre Marquet, ICRC spokesman for Europe and Central Asia, told AFP.

"They were there to evaluate the needs of the population in Donetsk. That is probably why they were freed so quickly, their mandate was very clear," he added. Earlier today, Kiril Rudenko, deputy spokesman for the self-proclaimed "People's Republic of Donetsk", said the Red

Cross workers had been detained because the rebels thought they were spies.

"They were arrested yesterday. We suspect they were engaged in espionage and we are currently checking these accusations," said Rudenko. The brief detention underscored jitters in the two regions of east Ukraine ahead of the disputed referendum likely to result in a new spike of geopolitical tension.

ASEAN must tackle China sea claims: Aquino

Manila

Philippine President Benigno Aquino III said on Saturday that he would raise his country's territorial dispute with China at a meeting of Southeast Asian leaders and call for support to resolve the conflict through international arbitration.

In a statement issued before departing for the 24th Association of Southeast Asian Nations summit in

Myanmar, Aquino said dialogue between two countries is not enough to settle issues that also affect others in the region.

Philippines presented evidence in March to an international tribunal against China's sweeping territorial claims in the South China Sea, ignoring Beijing's warning that the case would damage bilateral ties.

Manila brought its territorial dispute with China to



international arbitration in January 2013 after Chinese government ships took control of a shoal claimed by the Philippines. "Let us uphold and follow the rule of law in resolving territorial

disputes in order to give due recognition and respect to the rights of all nations," Aquino said in his statement. "We cannot rely just on dialogues between only two nations to settle issues that affect others in the region."

In addition to the Philippines and Myanmar, ASEAN also includes Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand and Viet-

nam. In the latest spat between the Philippines and China, Filipino maritime police arrested 11 Chinese fishermen who allegedly illegally collected more than 300 endangered marine turtles in a disputed shoal close to the western province of Palawan. Manila has ignored Beijing's demands to release the fishermen and their boat apprehended early last week by the police at the Half Moon Shoal.
