Riots case: Bailable warrant against Union Minister, BJP leaders

Muzaffarnagar

A bailable warrant has been issued against Muzaffarnagar riot accused including Union Minister Sanjeev Baliyan, BJP MP Bhartendu Singh, party MLA Suresh Rana and Sadhvi Prachi by a local court for not appearing before it in a case of violating prohibitory orders and inciting communal tension by making speeches.

Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Sitaram yesterday issued bailable warrant against Minister of State for Agriculture Baliyan, Singh, Rana, Prachi, BJP local leader Umesh Malik, ex-Block Head Virendra Singh, Chairman of a local cooperative society Shyampal among others and asked them to appear in court on November 2.

Hearing is getting delayed due to the non-appearance of the accused, the ACJM said.

According to prosecution, these accused are facing charges under IPC sections 188 (violating prohibitory orders), 353 (assault or criminal force to deter public servant from discharging his duty) and 341 (wrongful restraint). It is alleged that they participated in Nadala Mador panchayat meeting and violated prohibitory orders and incited violence through their speeches on August 30, 2013.

At present, the Indian Army is inducting women into the Signals, Engineers, Army Aviation (Air Traffic Control), Army Air Defence, Electronics and Mechanical Engineers, Army Service Corps, Army Ordnance Corps, Intelligence Corps, Army Education Corps and Judge Advocate General Branches/Cadres. The Indian Navy is inducting women in the Judge Advocate General, Logistics, Observer, Air Traffic Controller, Naval Constructor and Education branches/cadres. However, it has moved a proposal to induct women as pilots for its fleet of surveillance aircraft. With this decision to open up induction of women in the fighter stream, women have become eligible for induction in all branches and streams of the IAF. The IAF is at present inducting women in the Transport and Helicopter stream of the flying branch, Navigation, Aeronautical Engineering, Administration, Logistics, Accounts, Education and Meteorology branches. The Ministry of Defence has also taken up a comprehensive review pertaining to induction of women in Armed Forces, both in short service commission and permanent commission, and once finalised, more branches would be opened up for induction of women to give them the space which they deserve in the Armed Forces of the country, the statement said. People in Kenya drink cow blood but don't kill it: Bhagwat

Amid raging row over cow slaughter in India, RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat on Saturday said in Kenya, people sometimes drink blood of cows to survive, but they don't kill them or eat their meat, reports PTI. In certain situations like famine, people in Kenya drink blood of cows to survive but they don't kill them or eat their flesh, he said while speaking at a function here. They insert a tube made of bamboo in the jugular vein of cows and suck blood. But in no way the animal is killed for consumption since there is a ban on cow killing in the African nation, said Bhagwat, a veterinary doctor by training. He also ensure that while blood is sucked, the cow does not die due to it, Bhagwat added. His remarks came in the wake of controversy over ban on beef consumption in some States, including Maharashtra, and the recent lynching of a man in Dadri, Uttar Pradesh, after rumours that he and his family ate beef.

MLA to take bribes for welfare activities

JC Prabhakar Reddy, a legislator of the ruling Telugu Desam party in Andhra Pradesh, on Saturday said that he will start "accepting bribes" and "use the money for welfare activities" in his constituency as the state treasury was "cash-strapped", reports PTI. "I will take bribes from contractors. But I will take them by demand drafts. I will display the names of those who have given me the money I will take the money for my constituency," Reddy, who represents Tadipatri constituency in Anantapur district, said while speaking to reporters. "Financial situation of the state prompted me to take this decision... I will take white money. And I will show what I have done (with that money)." "There is no money in Andhra Pradesh. How will we complete development works? Why can't we do this?" he asked. He claimed that several contractors who were executing government works in his constituency had offered him money though he had never accepted it until now. Reddy's brother JC Diwakar Reddy is a senior TDP leader and a Lok Sabha member.
